Know how to tie knots?

If you have a clean, old t-shirt that you don't plan to wear any more, a pair of scissors, and the ability to tie knots, in about 10 minutes, you can repurpose the shirt into a simple tote that will be washable, reusable, and easy to carry with you when shopping. *No Sewing Required!*

This has to be one of the most fun ways to recycle! And a tote makes it easy to refuse single-use plastic bags.

Come to the Parkersburg library branch on Emerson Avenue on Monday, July 17th and drop in any time between 2:00 and 4:00pm and find us in a meeting room. If you have a shirt and scissors you can use, please bring them - but we will have some extra shirts and scissors available. There's no charge for this workshop, and kids are welcome!
